Community Concerns:

Mr. Fleshman had a concern about the EYA project, and the traffic on Branch Ave, and the traffic that still comes though the community.

Mrs. Ross had a concern about erosion. She had sent a letter to her Commissioner and had not gotten a response. Mrs. Ashby the office manager asked Mrs. Ross to resend her letter and to send it to the ANC office. We will address her concern. There is a sink hole in the area from this storm water run off. The erosion is at 32nd & Park Drive.

Commissioner Hammond will work with Mrs. Ross to see what can be done about this situation.

Mr. Jerry bought up the concern about the bike trails that Commissioner Richards had briefly discussed.

Ms. Eckles also attended the Great Streets meetings and had concerns about the issue with the Bikes and pedestrians sharing the same right of way.

It was requested by the community that the ANC would go on record opposing the sharing of right a ways (pedestrians with bikes) on Pa. Ave. from 28th Street to Southern
